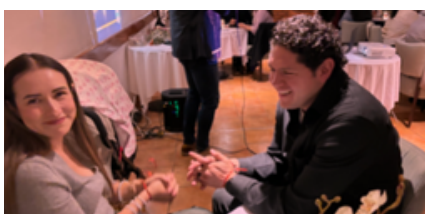
Multimedia Training

As a church, we have had the great blessing of raising a group of 38 servants and six coordinators who serve in different areas. Therefore, on February 25, we had a breakfast for the servants to communicate our plans for March 2024 to March 2025. It was a time to praise God for everything He has allowed us to accomplish, but it was also a time to inspire and look forward to what God wants to achieve in our midst.

3rd Anniversary Celebration

On March 7th, we celebrated our third anniversary with gratitude for the growth of our church under God's guidance. Despite the challenges, we have seen significant fruit, reflected in a record attendance of 126 people, including ten "Crece!" graduates, 40 participants in our discipleship processes, 38 servants, and five small groups. This indicates that we are being prepared for the integral growth that lies ahead. At this celebration, we launched the "Get Connected!" initiative, inviting the congregation to engage with Jesus, his mission, and the church. We are excited about the future and are confident in God's continued blessings on our community.
