

Ministry Activities and Projects for 2024

We are thankful to have reached our 18th year as a church, which we celebrated with the entire congregation. During this first quarter, we have had an increase in our attendance on Sunday services and an average of 15 new brothers and sisters growing and getting involved in the Lord's work. Many of these guests have been the fruit of the radio program we have in Nicaragua, which we believe continues to be a good tool.

Our youth group and children's ministry continue to grow, which gives us great joy since we are working with both the present generation and future generations. In February, we also conducted an evangelism outing in which 30 church servants collaborated, and 15 people professed faith in Jesus. In April, the women's group will meet and we have another evangelistic outing planned in order to continue fulfilling the great commission to preach the gospel to every creature.



We are happy that in the last meetings, we've have between 70 and 90 adults in attendance. We are grateful to God for the fruit we are having, but we want to continue working with passion throughout the year and not lose heart. We have continued with the weekly ministries of visitation, counseling and small groups; this allows us to be in contact most of the congregation during the week. We also reactivated our classes for new members and the biblical discipleship ministry with which we want to mold the new believers God is bringing to the Church. Once again, we thank all of you for your prayers and support, which is fundamental for us to continue. We are truly grateful for you!
